**Mon 30th** **Mixed Media Vase**  
Design a one-of-a-kind vase using colourful paper collage, magazine cutouts, and paint pens. We will explore the elements of composition to combine colours, patterns and shapes.



**Tues 1st** **Weaving Workshop**  
Create your own wonderful weaving using brown bags, stencils, and collage. Children will learn simple weaving techniques while crafting a functional basket to take home.



**Wed 2nd** **Pastel on Canvas**  
Create a vibrant canvas masterpiece inspired by Carmel van der Hoeven's distinctive style. We will learn how to blend and layer pastels for stunning visual effects.



**Thurs 3rd** **Flip Book Animation**  
Discover the magic of flip book animation! Inspired by Mo Willems' beloved "Don't Let the Pigeon" series, children will learn techniques to bring their own characters to life.



**Fri 4th** **Designer Collage Bags**  
Transform a bag into an extraordinary art piece inspired by Marimekko and Matisse. We will explore how these artists utilise patterns, colour, and composition to create something unique.



**Mon 7th** **Transform a Terracotta Pot**  
Breathe new life into a terracotta pot using vibrant collage and decoupage techniques. Children will take home a beautiful, personalised pot plant ready for their favourite plant or flowers.



**Tues 8th** **Lego Treasure Box**  
Craft the perfect container for your treasures using paper mache and tissue paper collage. Children will transform a shoebox into a personalized storage solution they'll be proud to display.



**Wed 9th** **Miniature Worlds**  
Create a scene inside a small box that opens to reveal a magical miniature world. Children will discover how small spaces can inspire big creativity through this delightful, detailed art form.



**Thurs 10th** **Greeting Cards**  
Design beautiful cards for any occasion using stamps, fine markers, and decorative embellishments. We will learn a variety of techniques to create treasured cards that friends and family will love.



**Fri 11th** **Egg Carton Sculptures**  
Upcycle ordinary egg cartons into extraordinary 3D face sculptures full of personality. We will transforming everyday materials into imaginative characters.
